






SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN ROMANIA

 In the context of EU integration, it is very important to look at the state of social economy in Romania.

















In Romania, social economy represents all activities organized independently by the public sector, whose purpose is to serve the general interest, by increasing employment of persons belonging to vulnerable groups and / or by producing and supplying goods, providing services or work.















15ES EU

Social Entrepreneurship relies on the following principles, included in the Romanian Social Economy Law:

- Priority given to the individual and social objectives, instead to the achievement of profit;
- 2. Solidarity and collective responsibility;
- 3. Convergence of interests of associated;













SESEU

4. Democratic control of the members, exercised over activities performed;

5. Separate legal entity, autonomous management and independence from public authorities;



6. Allocating most of the profit / financial surplus to achieve the general interest objectives, for the well-being of disadvantaged groups.

- (4) Employee Unions
- (5) Unions of Pensioners
